RING ONE - 10am START

JUDGE for Classes 1 - 8: Mr M Saunders

Class 1 - BROOD MARES. Any height

Class 2 - FOALS OF MARES IN CLASS 1

HUNTERS Class 3 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs, likely to exceed 158cm (15.2hh) at maturity
Class 4 - 4 yrs & over, exceeding 158cm (15.2hh)

SMALL HUNTERS Class 5 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs, likely to exceed 147cm (14.2hh) but unlikely to exceed 158cm (15.2hh) at maturity
Class 6 - 4 yrs & over, exceeding 147cm (14.2hh) but not exceeding 158cm (15.2hh)

HUNTER PONY Class 7 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs, unlikely to exceed 147cm (14.2hh) at maturity
Class 8 - 4 yrs & over, not exceeding 147cm (14.2hh)

JUDGE for Classes 9 - 14: Ms J Lane

RIDING HORSE Class 9 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs, likely to exceed 147cm (14.2hh) at maturity
Class 10 - 4 yrs & over, exceeding 147cm (14.2hh)

RIDING PONY Class 11 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs, unlikely to exceed 147cm (14.2hh) at maturity
Class 12 - 4 yrs & over, not exceeding 147cm (14.2hh)

ARABS Class 13 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs. Pure-bred, part-bred & Anglo
Class 14 - 4 yrs & over. Pure-bred, part-bred & Anglo

RING TWO - 10am START

JUDGE for Classes 17 - 22: Mr P Willis

Class 15 - NEW FOREST. Any age. This class may be split if sufficient entries

Class 16 - REGISTERED PART-BRED MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND. Any age. Class may be split if sufficient entries.

WELSH A, B, C & D Class 17 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs
Class 18 - 4 yrs & over

MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (EXCLUDING NEW FOREST & WELSH) (must be registered, see rule 10)
Class 19 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs
Class 20 - 4 yrs & over

JUDGE for Classes 21 - 28: Ms C Pratt

POTENTIAL COMPETITION HORSE
Class 21 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs
Class 22 - 4 yrs & over

POTENTIAL COMPETITION PONY
Class 23 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs
Class 24 - 4 yrs & over

WARMBLOODS: PURE-BRED & PART-BRED
Class 25 - 1, 2 & 3 yrs
Class 26 - 4 yrs & over

COLOUREDS (Piebald, Skewbald, Dun, Roan, Spots, Palomino, Cremello and any odd/unusual colours)
Class 27 - 1, 2, 3 yrs
Class 28 - 4 years & over

RING THREE - 10 am START

JUDGE for Classes 29 - 32: Mrs A Blake

Class 29 – BEST TURNED OUT. Any height. To be judged on cleanliness of animal & handler

Class 30 – NOVICE HORSE or PONY. Any age or height. Not to have been placed first in a showing class

Class 31 – CHILD HANDLER. Mares & geldings only. Child 10 yrs & under. To be judged on child's ability to handle horse/pony correctly & safely in the ring

Class 32 – CHILD HANDLER. Mares & geldings only. Child 11 – 16 years. To be judged on child's ability to handle horse/pony correctly & safely in the ring

JUDGE for Classes 33 - 42: Ms J Reardon

Class 33 – VETERANS. Exceeding 16 yrs (age to be displayed). Any height. Special rosette to oldest horse/pony "Patience of Jobe" Sash to best WDRC member.

Class 34 – NON-SHOW TYPE. Any age, any height. Blemishes will be disregarded but horse/pony must be sound

COB or COB TYPE Class 35 – 1, 2 or 3 yrs
Class 36 – 4 yrs & over

BEST CONDITION Class 37 – Grass Kept. Horse/pony any age. Cannot enter class 38 as well
Class 38 – Stabled or Part Stabled. Horse/pony any age. Cannot enter class 37 as well

Class 39 – HORSE or PONY SUITABLE FOR DRIVING

Class 40 – HACKS. Any age. Exceeding 147cm (14.2hh) (or likely to exceed 147cm (14.2hh) at maturity) but not exceeding or likely to exceed 158cm (15.2hh). Must be registered, see rule 11

BEST BLACK, BROWN, BAY, GREY, CHESTNUT OR ANY SOLID COLOUR

Class 41 – 1, 2 & 3 yrs. Any height

Class 42 – 4 yrs & over. Any height

SHOW RULES

1. Any complaints must be made in writing with a £10 deposit within 30 minutes of the alleged incident. The deposit will be refunded if the complaint is upheld
2. The judge's decision is final AT ALL TIMES
3. ALL DOGS TO BE KEPT ON A LEAD PLEASE. OWNERS MUST PROVIDE BAGS AND CLEAR UP ANY MESS LEFT BY THEIR DOG!
4. In the event of low numbers of entries, the Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes and withhold rosettes as appropriate
5. In the event of large numbers of entries, the Committee reserve the right to divide classes and award additional rosettes as appropriate
6. NO unauthorised persons are allowed in the show ring
7. All horses/ponies must be ready to enter the ring when called. COMPETITORS ENTERING CLASSES THAT MAY CLASH DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK. No entries will be refunded
8. Collecting ring stewards in all classes can refuse entries if judging has already started
9. Any Entire horse or pony over 2 years old MUST have the appropriate licence available for inspection at the show
10. All Mountain & Moorland ponies must be registered in the NPS Stud Book or in the Stud Book of their respective breed and must be shown in accordance with their breed standard. Breed Society numbers must be stated on the entry form
11. All Arabs, Anglo-Arabs & Part-bred Arabs must be registered in the appropriate register
12. All trophies are to be signed for before leaving the showground and must be returned by 15th July 2011

**** RANDOM CHECKS WILL BE MADE TO ENFORCE THESE RULES ****

Please note that there is no fresh water supply at the showground and competitors are advised to bring their own water
